#### **MANDATORY ITEMS**

All items on the mandatory items list are required for each participating Member. Cadets should use the Cadet Verified column to ensure that they have each item in the correct quantity. A SQN Officer will verify these items on the date scheduled for Kit Inspection prior to the trip departure date. Non compliance will preclude the Member from participating.

#### **OPTIONAL ITEMS**

All items on the optional items are optional, and suggested for the comfort of the Member. The "ADD" notation denotes that the Member can bring an additional number of the specified item.

#### **PROHIBITED ITEMS**

All items on this list are **PROHIBITED**, and will be seized if discovered during the Kit Inspection. Should these items be found during Customs clearance, the member will forfeit the item to Customs Officials, and it can not be recovered from Canada Customs.

### **Important Information for Cadets and Parents**

All clothing must fit the Cadet properly. All SQN Standing Orders are in place for this event, including Dress Regulations.

Cadets are cautioned against bringing expensive electronic equipment or other property, and do so at their own risk. Neither 142 SQN, 272 Sea, nor their respective Sponsors will be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.
